OVERVIEW

Not Every Change Creates Impact

We often measure life by visible changes: a new habit, a new role, a new plan, a new season. But Scripture calls us beyond movement to fruit - beyond activity to lasting influence.

SCRIPTURE FOCUS

**"You did not choose Me,
but I chose you and appointed
you that you should go and
bear fruit..."**

JOHN 15:16

CHANGE

Can be immediate, visible, and temporary. Change often begins with a decision, but it does not automatically produce transformation.

IMPACT

Is the lasting spiritual effect of a surrendered life. Impact multiplies when God uses your obedience to shape people, families, churches, and communities.

THE BIG IDEA

Biblical impact is not about being impressive. It is about being faithful enough for God to make your life fruitful.

THE PATH FROM CHANGE TO IMPACT



1. SURRENDER

Impact begins when you stop asking God to bless your agenda and begin offering Him your whole life.

Romans 12:1-2



2. OBEY

Small acts of obedience become powerful when they are repeated with humility, courage, and love.

James 1:22



3. MULTIPLY

God turns faithful obedience into fruit that reaches farther and lasts longer than you can see.

2 Timothy 2:2

ASK A BETTER QUESTION

Do not only ask, "What changed?"
Ask, "Who is being transformed?"

CHANGE-ONLY THINKING	IMPACT THINKING
Did I start something?	Did it produce godly fruit?
Did people notice?	Did people move closer to Jesus?
Was I successful?	Was I faithful?
Did it grow quickly?	Will it endure?

KEY TRUTH: You control your obedience. God controls the reach of your impact.

REFLECT. PRAY. ACT.

Let truth become a lived response.

REFLECTION

- 1 Where am I settling for visible change instead of lasting fruit?

- 2 Who is God asking me to influence through faithful obedience?

- 3 What one step can I take this week that may outlive the moment?

Jesus, do more than change my circumstances. Change my heart. Make me faithful in what You place before me, humble in how I serve, and courageous in how I obey. Use my life to point people toward You and produce fruit that lasts. Amen.
