OVERVIEW

Influence That Outlives the Moment

Biblical impact is not about being impressive. It is faithful obedience that points people to Jesus, strengthens others, and produces fruit that lasts.

SCRIPTURE FOCUS

“I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit and that your fruit should abide.”

JOHN 15:16

WHAT IMPACT IS

Impact is the lasting spiritual influence created when God works through a surrendered and faithful life.

WHAT IMPACT IS NOT

It is not applause, popularity, a platform, or visible success. Those things may disappear while true fruit remains.

THE BIG IDEA

God does not ask you to be famous. He asks you to be faithful with the influence He has given you.

THREE MARKS OF LASTING IMPACT



1. FAITHFULNESS

Lasting impact begins with obeying God in the assignment directly in front of you.

Luke 16:10



2. INVESTMENT

Impact grows when you encourage, teach, serve, and help another person follow Jesus.

2 Timothy 2:2



3. ENDURANCE

Fruit that lasts requires patience. We keep doing good even when results are not immediate.

Galatians 6:9

WHERE IMPACT BEGINS

Small acts of obedience become part of a larger story.

START WITH ONE PERSON

Encourage, disciple, listen to, pray for, or serve the person God has placed near you.

1 Thessalonians 5:11

USE WHAT YOU ALREADY HAVE

Your time, experience, gifts, testimony, and resources can all become tools in God's hands.

1 Peter 4:10

POINT PEOPLE TO JESUS

The goal is not to make people dependent on us, but to help them know and trust Christ.

John 3:30

LEAVE RESULTS WITH GOD

We plant and water faithfully, but only God can produce spiritual growth.

1 Corinthians 3:6-7

KEY TRUTH: You may never see the full reach of a life faithfully surrendered to God.
