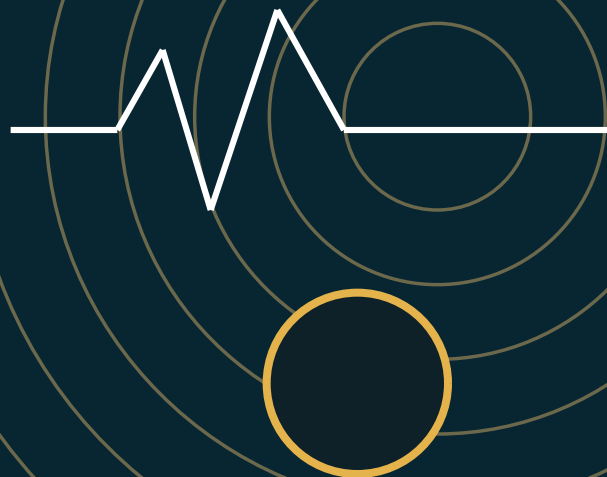
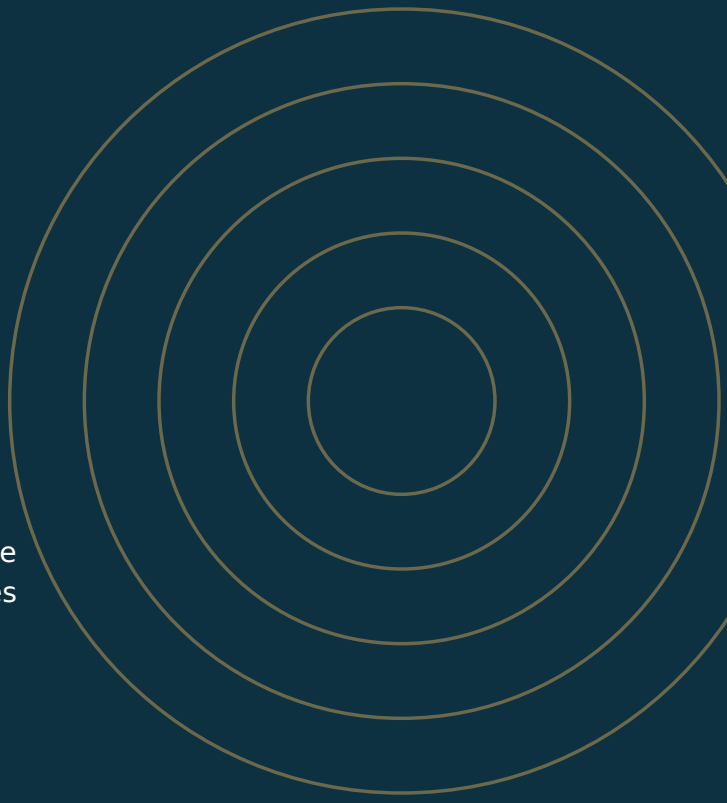

OVERVIEW

Love That Moves

The Bible never reduces love to emotion alone. Godly love chooses what is true, seeks another person's good, serves when it costs something, and keeps showing up. Love becomes alive when it moves from words into faithful action.

SCRIPTURE FOCUS

"Let us not love in word or talk but in deed and in truth."

1 JOHN 3:18

WHAT BIBLICAL LOVE IS

A Spirit-shaped commitment to seek another person's good through truth, patience, sacrifice, forgiveness, and service.

WHAT LOVE IS NOT

Approval of everything, avoidance of truth, sentimental words without action, or self-centered affection that disappears when costly.

THE BIG IDEA

Love becomes alive when the love of Christ moves through us in practical, truthful, sacrificial ways.

THREE MARKS OF LIVING LOVE



1. TRUTH

Love speaks and lives what is true.

Ephesians 4:15



2. SACRIFICE

Love gives rather than merely takes.

John 15:13



3. ACTION

Love becomes visible through service.

Galatians 5:13

WHERE LOVE BECOMES VISIBLE



LISTEN WITH PATIENCE

Give people your attention before giving them your opinion.

James 1:19



SPEAK TRUTH WITH GRACE

Real love does not flatter or wound; it tells the truth to help.

Ephesians 4:15



SERVE WITHOUT APPLAUSE

Do the good that needs doing, even when no one notices.

Matthew 6:3-4



FORGIVE AS CHRIST FORGAVE

Release resentment and pursue peace without ignoring wisdom.

Colossians 3:13

KEY TRUTH: Love is not proven by what we feel, but by how faithfully we live it.

Let the love of Christ become a lived response.

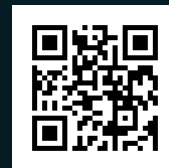
