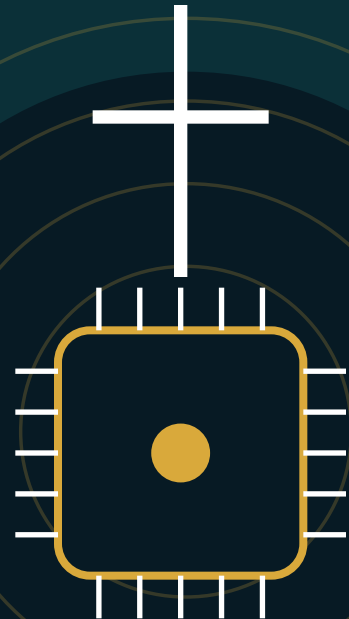

WILL AI REPLACE GOD?

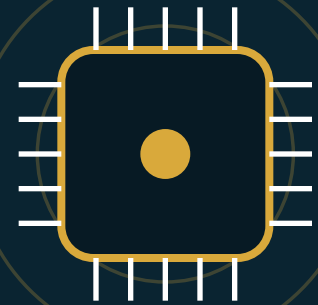
Artificial intelligence may imitate human intelligence, but it can never replace the eternal Creator.

It is not alive, all-knowing, morally perfect, sovereign, worthy of worship, or able to save a human soul.

Technology should serve wise, God-honoring purposes - not control your identity, choices, or devotion. **1 Corinthians 6:12**

TEST EVERYTHING BY SCRIPTURE

A confident answer is not necessarily a true answer. Compare every claim with God's Word. **Acts 17:11**

PROTECT HUMAN DIGNITY

People bear God's image. Efficiency must never replace compassion, responsibility, or love. **Genesis 1:27**

REFUSE DIGITAL IDOLATRY

Do not trust technology to provide the meaning, security, wisdom, or hope that belong to God alone. **Exodus 20:3**

KEY TRUTH: The future belongs to God - not to a machine.

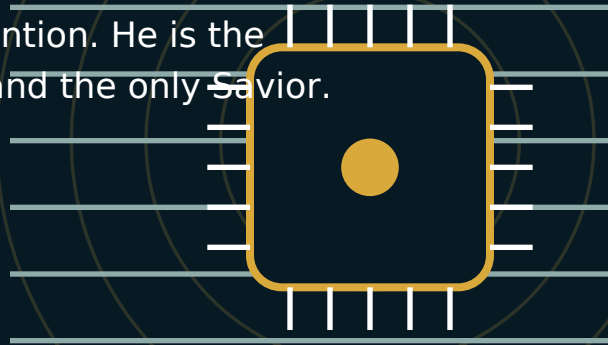
